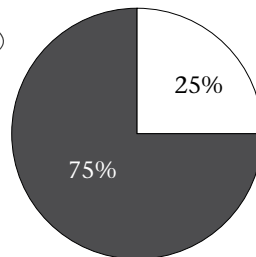

2017 YOUNG WOMEN SERVED

- Served 3 young women in the Maternity Home
- Served 5 in our Aftercare Program; housing, transportation, employment
- Two moms chose to single parent, one mom gifted her child in adoption
- 100% school success: 10th grade credit recovery courses
- 19 contact hours of Individual and group therapy provided by Sara Smith, LMSW
- Over 126 hours of Life Skills training including: parenting, meal planning, financial principals, sexual integrity, boundaries, child birth, sewing, and parenting options
- 18-year-old resident attended HiSet prep course at Community Renewal and passed English portion of the test
- 18-year-old attended Bee Safe Driving Academy and obtained Driver's License
- Residents completed a series of self-evaluations through the following courses: My Baby and Me, The Me I See, Basic Decision-Making Skills, Is Parenting For Me Now, and What About Adoption
- Private Health Care provided by Dr. Fred Kinder (OB)
- Transitional Apartment housed our 2nd adult mom and her child (past resident of 2012, she is employed and paying sliding scale rent for apartment)
