



I was thrilled when my great friend, Ann Inabnet, asked me if would like to plant a

prayer garden at Heart of Hope. Immediately, I began to ask God to give me HIS vision for its design. I had the plan in mind, submitted it for approval and began to make it become a reality. It wasn't long before I knew this garden had been designed by God way before I started on it. After I purchased the plants and some other materials. I wanted to plant it all without asking anyone to help, but to my surprise, a new customer of mine begged me to let her help me plant so she could get some exercise. I welcomed her help and warned her about the workout she was about to receive. She was eager to learn and expressed great joy over the experience, exercise, and absence of a cell phone. I told her how God had sent her to my rescue—that through her, God had provided the very thing I didn't think I needed—a helper!

The second phase required securing an entry arch, rose bushes, and a pallet of flagstone. When I drove to each of my trade businesses to buy the items, God spoke to me telling me to ask them if they wanted to have a part in creating the prayer garden. I simply explained about Heart of Hope and told them what I needed from them. Amazingly each one said, "Yes, just pick it out!" I told them they were part of God's plan and that they would be on our prayer list. That was all they wanted to hear!

Another part of my vision for the garden included a large cross made of bark-

What a marvelous on cedar, lashed together with ropes and an octagonal picnic table. I wondered how God was going to make this happen. A friend invited me to lunch at a new restaurant and as we walked up, lo and behold there were three picnic tables exactly like the one I wanted. I was able to get information about acquiring one. Now, how was He going to supply that cross? About the time I decided to drop the idea, I saw one in the yard of one of my friends. Her husband offered to make one for me if I would supply the wood. Driving home one day, I saw a man constructing a new fence with of all things, the 6 foot logs I needed! I stopped and shared my story; I left with the 2 logs and a promise from "Wild Bill" to come see the prayer garden. My cross was completed the next day!

On "cross installation day", I and my helper headed down I-20; the pickup loaded with rocks, plants, sakrete mix, a pink dogwood, and the lovely cross. We stopped to deliver some of the plants and as I glanced in the rear view mirror, I velled, "Where is the cross?" As impossible as it seemed, the cross had flipped out over the tailgate without either of us noticing. We were dumbfounded. We spent an hour and a half driving between Texas and Bossier City but found not a trace of the 6 foot cross! Tearfully, we pulled into Heart of Hope, planning to plant the pink dogwood and accent it with the rocks. We were met at the door by Kay who was full of hugs, prayers and empathy. It wasn't long before it hit me: God




